#### WHICH BIN: WASTE AND RECYCLING INFORMATION SESSION

Approx. 60 minutes. One session: \$385. Additional consecutive sessions: \$165.

Wondering which bin is best and where does it all go?

A KESAB education officer can come to you to shed some light on the subject with an engaging and informative presentation. Learn about the what, how and why of waste and recycling so that you have context to remember and empower positive choices.

Presentations can be structured to meet individual group needs and generally cover:

- what goes in each bin (and what doesn't)
- · the importance of recycling and food organics recovery
- · electronic waste and other tricky items.

#### **BEESWAX WRAP**

Approx. 60 minutes, max 25 participants. One session: \$550, Additional consecutive sessions: \$330

Encourage environmentally and economically conscious thinking while creating a plastic free alternative to cling film. In this sensory and creative workshop, participants make and take home a reusable, eco-friendly beeswax wrap along with DIY instructions and plenty of tips and tricks.

#### **DIY CLEANING AND PERSONAL CARE PRODUCTS**

Approx. 90 minutes, max 25 participants. One session: \$800, Additional consecutive sessions: \$440.

Want to reduce plastics and the chemicals in your home while saving money? Many common household products are easy to make yourself with cheap, everyday ingredients. In this hands-on workshop participants learn about plastic free living and make their own eco-friendly samples to take home and try.

This workshop can be coupled with a 1 hour presentation and Q&A on low living waste and plastic avoidance- a great option leading up to Plastic Free July or the holiday season.

\*This session requires access to a kitchen/microwave as well as a screen & projector.

#### **CONSCIOUS COOKING**

Approx. 90-120 minutes, max 25 participants. One session: \$880, Additional consecutive sessions: \$440.

This engaging, informative workshop provides kitchen tips and tricks to make the most of your food, using everything possible whilst being conscious of energy, water and waste.

Expand your horizons with ingredients you may not have considered or twists on old favourites that freeze well to save you time and money.

The workshop can either be run as an interactive hands-on workshop (requiring a fully equipped kitchen) or as a demonstration with samples for participants to try.

## **COMMUNITY WORKSHOPS**

#### **PAPERMAKING**

Approx. 60 minutes, max. 25 participants. One session: \$570. Additional consecutive sessions: \$275.

A practical, hands-on introduction to resource recovery, material science and environmentally conscious choices. Participants learn about resource recovery and make their own recycled paper to take home.

\*A wet area is recommended for this activity.

A DIY papermaking kit is available for hire from the KESAB website.

#### **COMPOST OR WORM FARM WORKSHOP**

Approx. 90 minutes, max 25 participants. One session: \$440, Additional consecutive sessions: \$220

Have you considered establishing your own compost system or worm farm? Our compost and garden expert can visit your site to demonstrate how to establish and maintain a healthy compost or worm farm. A great session for community gardens, this workshop can also be run as an indoor presentation.

\*This workshop length can be modified depending on your needs.
